Our YMLAEN strategy outlines the intention to accelerate the development and growth of our aquatic activities and sports at every level in Wales, from foundation level through grassroots and participation and onto our elite national teams, elevating the visibility of the sport and leading a movement to impact lives on and beyond the pool, lake or reservoir.

At the heart of its purpose, Swim Wales, with its proud and diverse foundations, will remain dedicated to increasing opportunities for Welsh children and adults to enjoy, participate, learn and compete in Welsh Aquatics. As a priority, we will continue to maintain our uniquely equal gender participation and address the inclusion of diverse communities and ensure that we have

AGUATICS FOR EVERYONE FOR LIFE.

This will be underpinned by decades of engaging with and delivering aquatics for our Welsh communities, the organisation pledges to understand, support everyone at every life stage and every age.

The organisation is also committed to opening up our sport to new audiences in every community, so aquatics better represents the rich diversity of the country it proudly represents, and ensures that our activities and sports continue to evolve and adapt to thrive in the future, helping to create a truly inclusive sport for all where everyone can belong, flourish and soar.

The recent partnership announcement with Speedo, British Swimming & the home nations will help develop and grow our participation in our activities and sports, supports this commitment as Swim Wales pledges to promote difference and embrace the opportunity to make the sport a possibility within everyone's reach.

Transforming aquatics for children and young people is a strategic priority to protect the future of the sport – swimming is a life skill, the only sport that can save your life. Working with schools and policy makers to extend physical literacy and water competence, and after the school day with a focus on specific provision on learning to swim will pave the way for greater accessibility, community participation and reduced drowning.

Our elite sport is in focus too, with the ambition for our elite squads to be the most successful home nation programme supporting our national teams to consistently win on the world stage. We will continue to ensure we have an outstanding talent pathway in place to fuel sustainable successes in and out of the pool, and we will set new standards for the 5 funded aquatic disciplines.

The commercialisation of our sport over the next decade is a priority, focusing on growing world-leading international and domestic competitions and events, and creating more careers in the sport for our young & talented Welsh athletes.

Grounded in feedback from the aquatic family, with over 10,000+ members and stakeholders consulted as part of the strategic process to understand what they wanted aquatics to 'look like' in 2026, the plan is aspirational and ambitious and sees the organisation pledge to continue to be a pathfinder for our sport as it embarks on its new journey.

To help realise the purpose there are 6 key 'blocks' in the YMLAEN strategy, underpinned by 20+ 'objectives' that will bring our strategy to life. Swim Wales have 4 core values that will provide a 'moral compass' to hold the organisation true to its purpose, and help guide the workforce, volunteer community, partners and wider aquatic family on the journey.

The YMLAEN strategy is supported by a fresh new look for Swim Wales, with a new brand identity and logo. Inspired by insights and feedback from the aquatic family and beyond, Swim Wales has created a confident yet friendly brand identity to dress them for their journey ahead.




